

Press Release – 11/17/2020

The Texas Department of State Health Services has reported an additional fatality from COVID-19 bringing our total to seven deaths. They reported that, as of November 17th, Callahan County has had 180 total confirmed cases. On November 2nd, our total case count was 137. We currently have 22 active cases.

As of the 16th, according to the DSHS web site, our 14-day new case total was at 43. Our new case total has not been under 30 since November 2nd. The Abilene trauma service area percentage remains below 15% so no additional restrictions apply at this time.

Please remember to wear your masks, particularly when inside or when you are not able to maintain at least six feet distance from others. Continue to use good disinfectant practices and use hand sanitizer. Utilize the curbside, delivery, or drive-through options when possible.
