Order of the Commissioners' Court of Callahan County, Texas Designation of Auxiliary Court Facilities

On this day there came to be considered by the Commissioners' Court of Callahan County, Texas, the matter of the designation of auxiliary court facilities in Callahan County, Texas.

On October 25, 2021, the Callahan County Commissioners' Court considered the need for locations to hold certain court proceedings, including the meetings of the 42nd District Court, the Callahan County Grand Jury, the County Court, the Justice Courts, and Callahan County Commissioners' Court. Due to the restoration of the historic 1929 Callahan County Courthouse, the Commissioners' Court does hereby order as follows:

- 1. The building commonly known as the Baird Activity Center located at 208 Walnut, Baird, Texas is hereby designated as an Auxiliary Court Facility for Callahan County, Texas for the purpose of holding grand jury, 42nd District Court, County Court, or Justice Court proceedings.
- 2. The building commonly known as the Temporary Operations Building located at 1257 FM 2047, Baird, Texas is hereby designated as an Auxiliary Court Facility for Callahan County, Texas for the purpose of holding 42nd District Court, County Court, or Justice court proceedings
- 3. The building commonly known as the City Council Chambers located at 328 Market Street, Baird, Texas is hereby designated as an Auxiliary Court Facility for Callahan County, Texas for the purpose of holding Commissioners' Court proceedings.
- 4. This Order does not preclude the designation of other auxiliary facilities.
- 3. This Order shall continue in effect until rescinded by further Order of the Court.

This Order shall become effective on the date of its passage by the Commissioners Court.
