ORDER LIFTING OUTDOOR BURN BAN

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 352.081 of the Local Government Code, the Callahan County Judge finds that circumstances present in all or part of the unincorporated areas of Callahan County that would create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning no longer exist due to heavy rains throughout the county and,

WHEREAS, such a finding authorizes the issuance of an order by the County Judge which lifts the prohibition or restrictions on outdoor burning.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED that the prohibition on outdoor burning in unincorporated areas of Callahan County is hereby lifted with these provisions:

- a. Extreme caution should be used when outdoor burning.
- b. Outdoor burning should not occur when windspeeds are 15 MPH or higher.
- c. Persons intending to plan or execute any outdoor burning shall notify the Callahan County Sheriff's office at (325) 854-1444 and their nearest volunteer fire department.

ORDERED by the Callahan County Judge on October 15, 2021 and executed on the same date.
