Data from the Texas Department of State Health Services disclosed the following Callahan County information, effective January 18, 2021:

Fatalities from COVID-19 - 27

Confirmed cases - 481

Probable cases - 450

Active cases (confirmed and probable) - 18

14-day new case total - 69

As of January 18<sup>th</sup>, DSHS reported that the percentage of hospital beds in the Abilene Trauma Service Area (TSA) utilized by COVID-19 patients is over 22%. This percentage has been over 15% for more than 14 days which resulted in mandatory closure of bars and restrictions on restaurants to 50% capacity.

200 doses of the vaccine are supposed to be received by Callahan County providers this week.
