

**CALLAHAN COUNTY, TEXAS RESPONSE TO SUBMITTED QUESTIONS
REGARDING REQUESTS FOR QUALIFICATIONS NO. 2020-003 AND 2020-004
FOR ARCHITECTURAL AND OTHER PROFESSIONAL SERVICES**

Three questions were timely submitted via email to the County Judge on December 21, 2020 regarding the RFQ's. The Callahan County Judge submitted written answers to each question on December 21, 2020. A summary of these questions and the County's responses appear below:

Question 1: This question related to whether the Callahan County Courthouse and Callahan County Annex Building (being public buildings located adjacent to each other at West 4th Street, Baird, Callahan County, Texas 79504) would remain as separate plats for the work to be conducted at each separate project site. The question related to both RFQ 2020-003 and RFQ 2020-004.

The Callahan County Judge's answer was as follows: "It is my understanding that a survey conducted that separated the plats. Given the perpetual easement the county gave to THC, I do not anticipate the county joining the two plats." ("THC" means the Texas Historical Commission, an administrative agency of the State of Texas.)

Question 2: This question related to whether the radio dispatch tower/antenna of the Callahan County Sheriff's office was included in the Scope of Work for RFQ 2020-004.

The Callahan County Judge's answer was as follows: "I believe that the tower/antenna would be completed engineered and constructed by the radio company selected to perform this. If we need to add a tower pad and/or grounding, etc. we could probably do this with a change order."

Question 3: This question related to whether the County intends to maintain two separate emergency generators for the Callahan County Annex Building and Callahan County Courthouse and related to RFQ 2020-004.

The Callahan County Judge's answer was as follows: "It is not a part of the scope of work for this RFQ. Right now, please consider one for each facility."
